MINUTES OF MEETING – NOVEMBER 8, 2004

A special meeting of the Chestnuthill Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 a.m. on Monday, November 8, 2004, at the Municipal Building, Rte 715, Brod-headsville. Those present were Chuck Gould (Chairman), Maureen Tatu (Vice-Chair) and Supervisor Leigh Kane. Atty. Joseph P. McDonald, Jr. was absent.

The purpose of this meeting was to consider a resolution declaring portions of the Chest-nuthill Township Zoning Ordinance, Ordinance #00-03, substantially invalid and propos-ing to prepare a municipal curative amendment pursuant to 53 p.s. 10609.2.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Leigh Kane.

On the recommendation of the Planning Director, David Albright not to do a curative amendment, we can apply to the County for reimbursement of half of the cost to work on the Transfer of Development Rights issues in the Zoning Ordinance. This would clarify some of the cloudy issues. On motion made by Leigh, seconded by Maureen it was voted to repeal the Transfer of Development Rights part of the Ordinance, this does not apply to any project already in the works. (3-0)

Bill Hopkins. There are two utility companies interested in the project with central water and sewer.

Adjournment. There being no further business, on motion made by Maureen, seconded by Leigh it was voted to adjourn at 7:45 a.m. (3-0)
