MINUTES OF MEETING – FEBRUARY 26, 2007

A special meeting of the Chestnuthill Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:53 a.m. on Monday, February 26, 2007, at the Township Municipal Building, Rte 715, Brodheadsville, PA. Those present were Chuck Gould (Chairman), Maureen Tatu (Vice Chairman), Leigh Kane (Supervisor) and Atty. Joseph P. McDonald, Jr.

The purpose of this special meeting was to deliberate and render a decision on the appeal of David S. Wengerd from the decision of the Sewage Enforcement Officer denying permit application #R-00119 for an on-site sewage disposal system on an 8.04 acre parcel in Indian Mountain Lakes.

After a brief discussion, on motion made by Maureen, seconded by Leigh it was voted to deny the appeal of Mr. Wengerd. (3-0) Several reasons stated for denial were this lot had no assigned lot number and no sewage testing (all other lots shown on the plan had numbers and testing) and it is believed that this lot was not intended to be a building lot. Following the vote Solicitor McDonald announced that formal written findings and conclusions would follow pursuant to the Local Agency Law.

**Adjournment.** There being no further business, on motion made by Maureen, seconded by Leigh it was voted to close the meeting and adjourn at 7:59 a.m. (3-0)
