

Safety is our # 1 Concern.

Please familiarize yourself with the following Safety Guidelines when picking up litter on our Township Roads;

- Wear appropriate, brightly colored clothing that covers arms and legs and also wear sturdy shoes or boots.
- Carpool to Township road being cleaned. Pull all vehicles as far off the side of the road as possible. Be Careful of blind curves in road.
- Face oncoming traffic when picking up litter and look-up often. Be mindful of Traffic!
- Watch footing, stay off rocky, steep areas. Use approximately an 8 foot distance from the road edge for the area to be picked.
- Avoid poison ivy and thorny plants.
- Use bug spray and always check yourself for ticks.
- Utilize caution when picking up Litter, sealed containers, medical waste (syringes, pill bottles ect.), or sharp objects. Please contact a team leader for any items in question.
- Do not overload bags. Place larger items next to bags for truck pick-up.
- Rest whenever necessary!
- Always use common sense!!

PIC Day procedure;

- The evening before PIC day you will receive an email from Sign-up Genius informing you of the road you will be meeting at to clean up. You may also be notified the same way if the PIC day is cancelled due to inclement weather.
- Team leaders will be setting up Litter Crew signs on both ends of the road and buckets, bags, safety vests along with picking tools will be at one end of the road.
- After all litter is picked up, please leave the equipment where it was found and text/call a team leader for truck pick-up.
