## Remember to maintain your Drainage Swales/Ditches and Driveway Pipes

Property owners are responsible for basic maintenance of drainage swales/ditches,
driveway pipes and related stormwater facilities installed in or on their property



- Maintenance on drainage swales and driveway pipes include:
  - Mowing of grass or other vegetation
  - Removal of leaves, sticks, branches, debris, garbage, trash or any other encumbrance that reduces or obstructs the free flow of water through the drainage swale or pipe
- Should drainage pipes be damaged or degraded such as crushed, broken, collapsed, corroded or leaking; the property owners shall be responsible for the repairs or replacement of the pipes
- **Remember:** Following these steps can help your water flow, prevent flooding & make our roads last longer!
